6 top reasons owner operator semi truck companies fail

The top reasons owner operator trucking companies fail include:

1. Poor financial planning and cash flow management

Poor financial planning and cash flow management is a major downfall for many owner operators. They fail to properly budget for significant operating costs like fuel, maintenance, truck loan payments, insurance premiums and others. Many also do not account for the irregular cash flow common in the freight business. Without adequately planning for downturns or seasonal slow periods, owner operators find themselves cash-strapped and unable to cover fixed overhead costs when revenue decreases. 
2. Regulatory non-compliance

Non-compliance with FMCSA regulations is another common pitfall. 


