

TOWN OF SUTTON, WEST VIRGINIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 2 SECTION 209 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SUTTON

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Sutton, West Virginia, is authorized under West Virginia Code §§ 8-11-3, 8-11-4, and 8-12-5, and other applicable provisions of state law, to adopt, amend, repeal, and reenact ordinances governing municipal affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the existing provisions of Chapter 1, Article 2 Section 209 contain outdated, unclear, or fragmented language that no longer reflects current Town policy or best practices; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it in the best interest of the Town and its residents to repeal the existing provisions and adopt a consolidated, modernized replacement that is clear, enforceable, and consistent with current West Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUTTON, WEST VIRGINIA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Repeal

Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 209 of the Code of the Town of Sutton, as previously enacted and amended, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Reenactment and Replacement

Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 209 of the Code of the Town of Sutton is hereby reenacted in its entirety to read as follows:

Unless altered by majority vote, the regular order of business shall be:

1. Call to order
2. Roll call
3. Special Guests/Topics
4. Old Business
5. New Business
6. Approval of minutes
7. Public comment
8. Communications from the Mayor
9. Standing committee reports
10. Special committee reports
11. Adjournment

(Section last amended 2022 then in 2026)

Section 3. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance or the reenacted provisions is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption, following required readings, approval, and publication as provided by law.
