Spotlight Story

Students in Ms. Chambers' Environmental Science class recently traded their textbooks for a hands-on learning experience at the magnificent Atlanta Botanical Garden.

The field trip was an enriching opportunity for students to study the core standards of the class in a more immersive and in-depth way. Instead of just reading about ecosystems, plant diversity, and conservation, the students got to see these concepts in action.

Throughout the garden's diverse collections, students explored several key environmental science themes:

- Ecosystems and Interdependence: The tropical, desert, and local plant houses provided perfect real-world examples of different biomes and how various species rely on one another to thrive.
- Plant Biology and Adaptation: Students got an up-close look at how different plants have adapted to their unique environments—from the water-storing succulents in the desert house to the humidity-loving orchids.
- Conservation in Action: The trip highlighted the critical role of botanical gardens in plant conservation, especially for endangered and rare species. This tied directly into our recent unit on human impact on the environment.

The students were engaged and curious, making observations, taking notes, and connecting what they saw with the lessons we've covered in class.
