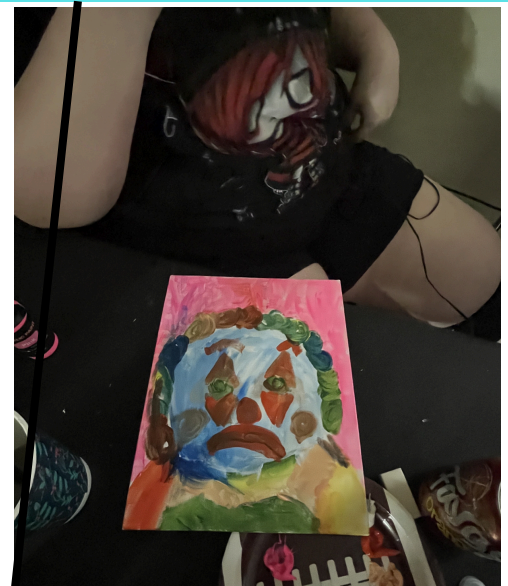
Healing Through Art: Emotional Wellness & Expression
