
President's Report

UPDATE DEC 2024

The Tustin City Council will meet on December 17, at 7 pm, regarding the Rezone Project which includes Enderle Center, Tustin Market Place and Tustin Legacy.

At the last Council meeting in November, out-going Councilwoman Becky Gomez deferred any decision on this project--with agreement by out-going Councilwoman Letitia Clark--until the two newly-elected (and subsequently installed on December 3rd) Councilmen John Nielsen and Lee Fink officially take those vacant seats, which they now have done.


