
Our OCGOP Chairman Fred Whitaker did a great job at our January 25th meeting to cite what happened. While what occurred in 2018 was grievous, some of their tactics were legal. While Ballot Harvesting is legal in our state, and several others, there were however other tactics used that were not, i.e. assisted voting, overstuffed ballot boxes, and extra ballots found in plastic containers.

The biggest problem in OC was that many people did not receive their Absentee ballots by mail and when they got to the polls their votes were pronounced provisional, because they were told they already voted. Also, seven Ballots were found in the bushes in one area of OC. Voter Fraud is alive and real. Katherine's tells us to **NEVER VOTE by MAIL.** In the future, go to the polls to vote, or give your ballot ONLY to a trusted family member or friend to hand deliver. Katherine Gerdis also reports that besides cleaning up ballot rolls, we need to build an organization with **one person in**

each city to be a captain to represent the Election Integrity Project to insure and secure integrity in our elections in 2020. The Integrity in Elections is a 503c Non-Partisan Organization. We also heard news about the new CRFW reorganization. Details are still on going at this time ...so we'll provide more information in our March 2019 Newsletter.

We welcome your ideas and suggestions as to how we can keep you abreast of political issues... as well as give voice to any and all concerns so we can all contribute to help "Make America Great Again!"

Trump's Salary and the White House Salaries

On Friday, the Trump administration released their annual report to Congress on White House Office Personnel. It includes the name, status, salary and position title of all 377 White House employees. The report also said that Trump decided not to take a dime of his salary; instead he donated it to an amazing cause.

The report also showed that President Trump is far better at saving money. The total annual White House salaries under Trump are \$35.8 million vs \$60.9 million under Obama, a savings of \$25.1 million.

Here are some other key findings:



There are 140 fewer employees on White House staff under Trump than under Obama at this point in their respective presidencies.

Thirty-nine fewer staffers are dedicated to The First Lady of the United States (FLOTUS). Currently, there are only five staffers dedicated to Melania Trump vs. forty-four staffers who served Michelle Obama (FY2009).

However, it's what the report said Trump did with this salary that has everyone talking.

Instead of taking his salary, Trump donated all \$400,000 to the Department of the Interior where it will be used for construction and repair needs at military cemeteries! AMAZING! It's so great to have a President who loves our brave military men and women so much!
