President's Report January 2023


Dear TARWF Members,

City of Tustin History



Donna Peery, Office Manager of the **Tustin Historical Society** has agreed to contribute articles for our newsletter regarding Tustin history and Tustin armed forces service personnel.

When Charles A Vance passed away in 1959, it was said that Tustin lost one of its most loyal citizens.



The Kansas native started and owned the Chula Vista State Bank from 1912-1916 before moving to Tustin in 1917. Once here, he purchased the First National Bank of Tustin (and his house) from Vinnie Cranston and owned the bank until his passing.

The bank was run by Mr. Vance and his three employees. When President Franklin Roosevelt wanted the banks to close in 1933 to avoid a run on the banks, Mr. Vance complied, but kept his back door open to ensure that his fellow Tustin residents would be taken care of. He was known for running a sound financial

operation through the Great Depression of the 1930's. The bank and Tustin survived thanks to Mr. Vance.

His house at 420 W. Main Street in Tustin still stands today. Mr. Vance loved cigars and it's been said that residents can still smell a whiff of cigar smoke occasionally!





Waldron George Karp

Tustin Police Officer Born: 25 May 1941


End of Watch: 7 January 1972

Waldron George Karp, Walt or Wally to his friends and family, was born on May 25, 1941 in Waterton, New York to Mae Ina Meagan and stepson of Clarence Shawcross. Although some records give his birth year

as 1940, his military records indicate 1941.

After attending Indian River Central High School, in New York, Karp enlisted in the United States Navy on July 22, 1959, attached to a sea rescue unit. He would later become a Dental Technician. Karp served in Trinidad and in South Vietnam. It is said that he treated many in the nearby villages in Vietnam, becoming their village doctor. He earned the Air Medal, receiving it at El Toro Marine base in October 1965. He was honorably discharged from the Navy on August 21, 1967.

Karp was married three times, first to Penelope Ferreira. They had two children, a son Waldron Jr, died shortly after birth. A daughter Sheryl was born in 1962. A brief marriage to Linda Christensen followed and ended in divorce. He had just married his third wife, Geraldin Robles Zimmer, in October 1972. Sadly, he was shot two months later.



Officer Waldron Karp succumbed to his injuries on January 7, 1973. He is buried at Sanford Corners Cemetery in Calcium, New York


How did a virus cancel the Constitution? Did the lockdowns rob of us of our sanity? Or was it the woke hysteria that ignited our collective madness?
