


BRANCHING OUT

City of Tustin History



Donna Peery, Office Manager of the **Tustin Historical Society** has agreed to contribute articles for our newsletter regarding Tustin history and Tustin armed forces service personnel.



Tustin History- Tress Whitley

If you wanted a glimpse of women in the 1950's and 1960's and turned on your television, you probably saw Harriet Nelson, June Cleaver or Donna Reed. They were always perfectly dressed, their hair beautifully done, wearing their pearls and waiting patiently at home for their bread-winning husbands to come home from work.

Texas born Tressie Lorine Whitley would have fit that profile perfectly with one big exception. Tress was an early entrepreneur in Tustin!

Tressie was born in Lipan, Texas to Henry and Lula Kelly. At a community dance, as a young teen, she met the love of her life, Joe Bailey Whitley and they married in 1926 when Tress was only 15. By 1935, Tress and Bailey

were living in Tustin and starting their family, sons Donald, Reginald and daughter JoAnn. Their house was (and is still standing) at 180 El Camino Real.

In the 1940's Tress opened Tres' Beauty Salon, working out of her home. By 1950, her business moved to the upstairs at the Knights of Pythias building at El Camino and Main Street. In the 1960's she employed 10 stylists and had moved her business to Jamestown Village. Tress won many styling competitions throughout California, became the Director of Cosmetology for the State of California, spoke at civic groups in Tustin, and wrote a weekly beauty column in the Tustin News! In the 1960's, even after owning a successful Tustin business, Tress traveled to London to train under world famous Vidal Sassoon!

Her granddaughter, Christine Wall Burnett, fondly remembers Tress and Bailey as loving grandparents. Tress was a terrific cook and Chris recalls Tress stirring pots with her many bangle bracelets on. Bailey was a jack of all trades, working in a packing house, owning his own laundry repair business, a handyman that could fix anything, and was always whistling a tune. Their work ethic was a wonderful example to their children, as they started a long family line of self-employed entrepreneurs.

After selling her business in 1978, Tress and Bailey moved to Desert Hot Springs to enjoy retirement. When Bailey passed away in 1993, Tress returned to Tustin to be closer to her family. Tress Whitley passed away in 1997 and is buried beside Bailey in Cathedral City, California.

Jeffrey Lea Martin was born August 9, 1944 in Farragutt, Idaho the oldest of two children and only son of World War II and active duty soldier Gerard Arthur Martin and Bette Lea Gaskill Martin. The family, along with younger sister Janine moved to Eveningside Drive in Tustin when Gerard left the military.

Jeff attended Tustin schools, graduating from Tustin High in 1962. He was a Varsity swimmer all four years and attended Orange Coast College before transferring to San Diego State University. A Political Science major, Jeff had leadership roles as the President of his fraternity and a member of the Student Council.

After graduation he entered the United States Marine Corps, completing Officer Candidate School in Quantico Virginia in April 1967.

His father said in a news article that Jeff was proud to serve in the infantry in Vietnam and had turned down an administrative position to do the














"grunt" work.

He was the Platoon leader when on July 23rd, the platoon was attacked by mortar fire. Lt Martin was wounded and taken to a military hospital where he died 3 days later. A Marine Corps buddy wrote a remembrance that "Your laugh, Humor, and Fun loving nature will always be remembered. It was however, all surpassed by your love of country, sense of duty, and sacrifice for your Corps and men".

He is the recipient of the Purple Heart, National Defense Medal, the Vietnam Campaign Medal and the Vietnam Service Medal. He is buried at Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery in San Diego.


