



meetings. So tasteful and being tall always looked like a model even as she aged so gracefully. That aside she was as nice as she was attractive. God bless her. Donna”

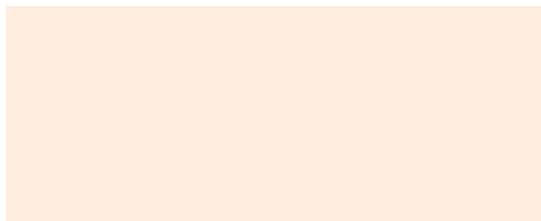
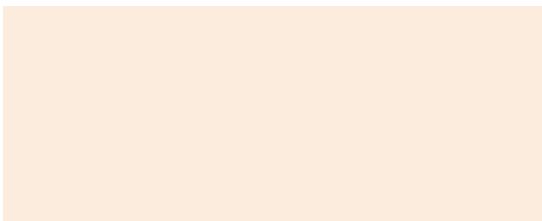

Over the last year, the Tustin Unified School District (TUSD) Board has been unresponsive to the public's multiple requests for information, meetings, and clarification around curriculum and programs being introduced into TUSD schools, all while they have been avoiding concerns over declining academic performance.

Because of this continual lack of transparency, we filed California Public Records Act requests which revealed a willful act by both the Board and Superintendent Franklin to mislead and withhold critical information from residents.

TUSD schools are no longer the "Blue Ribbon" schools they once were. The most recent test scores (pre-Pandemic) show **47%** of TUSD students perform below standard in Math and **38%** below in English. Our minority students are disproportionately impacted with Hispanic and Black students testing **70%** below standard in Math and **56%** below in English. While the school board will tout the District's overall outperformance of California's average test scores, bear in mind that "benchmark" is 40% proficiency in Math and 51% in English. Nearly one-third of TUSD schools score below those state averages.

TUSD schools located in lower-income communities suffered the worst academically, many situated within Trustee Recall areas. Nine TUSD schools report test scores as much as 25% below the California average math test score, and eight report test scores as much as 26% below the California average English test score.

This academic failure occurred while TUSD and its School Board put our taxpayer money and resources into pushing a political agenda by unanimously approving controversial Critical Race Theory curricula as part of an Ethnic Studies course. Tustin residents and taxpayers deserve a school board committed to the academic success of its students, not a political agenda.

Earlier this year, a group of parents met with TUSD Assistant Superintendents Matos and Villegas to express their concerns about a "White Savior Complex" assignment that was given to high school students. Parents were concerned that schools were incorporating unapproved Critical Race Theory-based curriculum in kids' classes. Parents were told at that time that it was an "unauthorized assignment" given by a substitute teacher and the substitute teacher had been let go. In August, however, parents discovered that TUSD had hired this substitute as a full-time teacher at Foothill High School.

Due to the lack of response and transparency from the District, parents were suspicious that CRT was being taught under the Ethnic Studies curriculum and submitted several California Public Records Act requests to the District. The records the District provided confirmed their suspicions. Board Trustee Allyson Damikolas' email to Superintendent Franklin admitted that Ethnic Studies does have some "component of Critical Race Theory," and she coached Dr. Franklin on how to soften the language so as to deceive parents. Records also show that Dr. Franklin liked the White Savior Complex assignment so much that he recommended it be incorporated into the new Ethnic Studies course. Additionally, Unit 3 of the Ethnic Studies curriculum teaches students how to become activists for LGBTQ issues, Marriage and Gender Equality, the BLM movement, and provides lessons on labor union activism.

These controversial subjects have nothing to do with ethnicity. Despite the fact that TUSD's own survey results show that nearly 90% of students, teachers, staff, and parents indicate "people from different races, ethnicities or cultures are treated fairly" and 91% of parents "value diverse friendships for their children," the Board unanimously approved the controversial Critical Race Theory under the Ethnic Studies umbrella. Currently, Ethnic Studies is taught as a pilot elective course in high school. Parents request that the Board discontinues this course immediately, as the Ethnic Studies course has components of Critical Race Theory being taught to students.

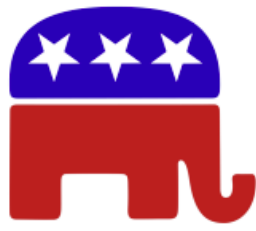
