Our Happy Hour conversation this month was all about who had made it (depending on the hour of the day of course) and who still had a chance.

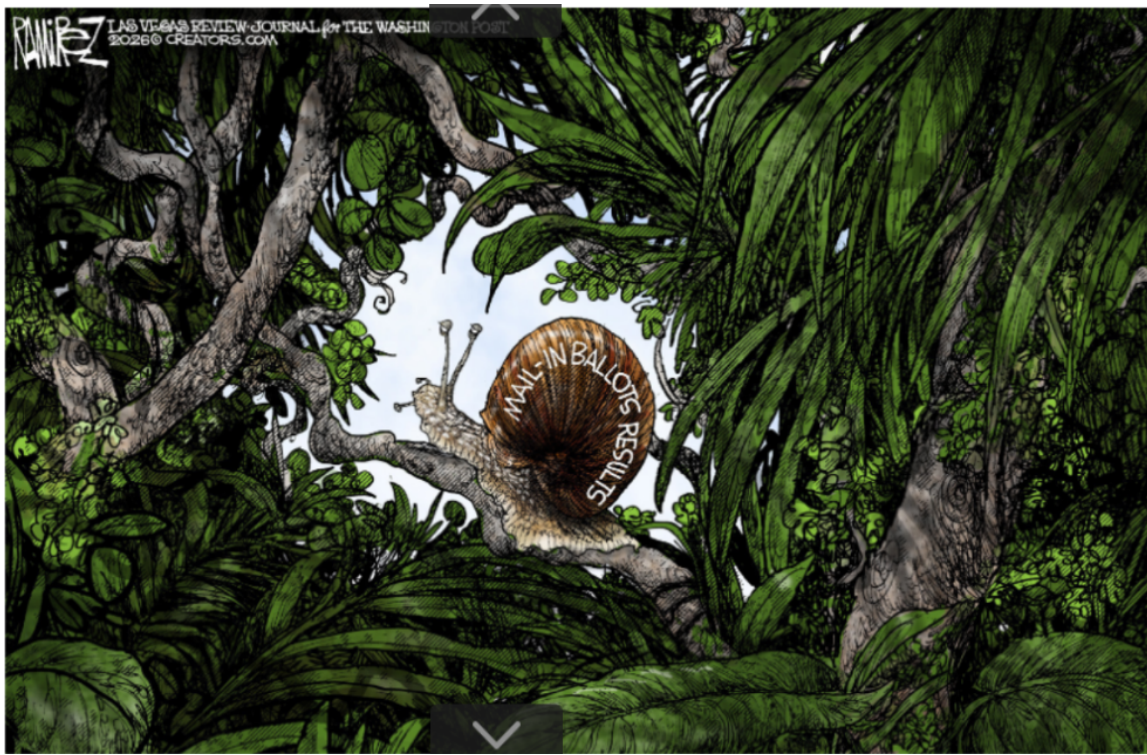

## Legislation Report

### FEDERATION ACTIVITIES TO “KEEP NINE” ON THE SUPREME COURT

In March, I attended the National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW) Legislative Day in Washington, D.C. NFRW emphasized its support for amending the US Constitution to officially establish nine as the the number of Supreme Court justices. Currently, Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution establishes a federal Supreme Court and justices but does not designate a specific number of justices.

Since the NFRW Legislative Day, Congress has taken important actions to advance this issue. In May, the House Judiciary Subcommittee on the Courts, Intellectual Property, Artificial Intelligence and the Internet, held a hearing on “Court Packing: Threat to the Supreme Court’s Legitimacy.” In early June, the

House Judiciary Committee approved House Joint Resolution (HJR) 1, authored by Republican Arizona Congressman Andy Biggs, which proposes “The Supreme Court of the United States shall be composed of nine justices consisting of one chief justice and eight associate justices.” As written, HJR 1, upon 2/3 passage by both the House and Senate, would require ratification by 3/4 of the states within 7 years of its submission for ratification. As HJR 1 heads for a vote by the full House of Representatives, NFRW President Martha Jenkins has sent out a “Call to Action” for each Federation member to contact her congressman and register her support for HJR 1 — the “Keep Nine” Amendment. This amendment will protect the Court’s independence from partisan court-packing. After hearing arguments in favor of court expansion, NFRW President Jenkins succinctly-stated: “The only reason Democrats want to add justices now is to change the ideological balance of the Court.” Please contact your congressman and register your support for the “Keep Nine” Amendment!
