

Travel and Boarding Preparation Checklist

In an effort to ensure your success in working through the many preparatory tasks, the following checklist is offered for your consideration. Please review and plan early for the tasks below in order to avoid any snags in travel or care, or delays in breeding. Please email information hightlighted below to stud owner at least one week prior to expected breeding.

| Please notity stud owner what type of communication you would prefer regarding this breeding: |
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| Stud dog owner to treat the breeding as confidential and not discuss with anyoneStud dog owner to treat as confidential until pregnancy is confirmed |
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| Preparation for Boarding: |
| The following costs and arrangements associated with boarding or live breeding are the sole responsibility of bitch owner. |
| Arrangements, if needed, should be made by bitch owner directly with facility or service provider: |
| Insertion of microchip |
| Collar and identification tags, to be worn at all times until bitch is returned to owner |
| Airline travel arrangements |
| Health certificate(s) for travel |
| Crate and equipment for travel (see airline requirements on airline website or call airline for specifications) |
| Ground transportation (if other than to/from Seattle/Tacoma or Everett/Paine Field airports) |
| Brucellosis test performed within 2-14 days of planned breeding. |
| Evidence of up to date vaccinations for Parvo, Corona, Bordetella, Rabies, Distemper |
| Evidence of negative test for stool ova and parasites within 2-14 days of planned breeding |
| Disclosure of all relevant medical conditions, medications needed; medications to be administered during boarding |
| are provided (along with clear instructions for administration) by bitch owner to stud owner |
| Contact information for veterinary or reproductive care provider |
| Bitch is bathed, brushed, trimmed prior to transfer to stud owner |
| Other personal care equipment and supplies (dental care, etc.) are provided to stud owner if needed during boarding |
| Evidence of authorization from all co-owners for breeding bitch (email, text message, etc.) |
| Send food and/or treats to be delivered to stud owner's residence. Usually a 5-10 pound bag of food is sufficient. |
| Allow at least 3-4 days for Amazon delivery. |
| Notify stud owner when to expect a delivery |
| Delivery address: 20325 156th Ave NE, Woodinville, WA 98072; Monday delivery is preferred but not required. |
| UNLESS SPECIFIED IN THE CONTRACT Boarding includes ground transportation to and from the following airports |
| Seattle/Tacoma International Airport or Everett/Paine Field Airport ¹ . |
| Scheduling must be agreed upon by stud owner before travel arrangements are finalized.: |
| Payment for any needed routine or emergent veterinary services during the stay is the sole responsibility of bitch |
| owner. Payment is to be made directly to the veterinary service provider. Unless bitch owner specifies otherwise, |
| the following veterinary services are used. |
| Routine care: Kenmore Veterinary Hospital Emergency Care: VCA Lynnwood Veterinary Specialties |
| Reproductive Care: Animal Hospital by the Sea, Langley, WA |
| Frequency of feedings: Amount per feeding: |
| Medications or supplements: Please label each container with your bitch's name, frequency/timing, amount. |
| Unique preferences of bitch or any specific requests for care (eg. how does bitch communicate to you that she needs |
| to go outside?) |
