2025-2026 Registration Information


For those of you who have children moving to Pre-K or Transitional Kindergarten, your class placement confirmation letter was sent via email January 31. If you did not receive an email from school with confirmation information and turned in a registration form please check your junk/spam email and contact the office. If you have made other plans for the 2025/2026 school year, we thank you for sharing your child with us this year and wish you the best in the future.

September 2025 tuition is due by March 31 to secure your child's spot in their class. This allows us the ability to plan and prepare so we are ready for students to arrive in September. September 2025 tuition is refundable up to June 6, 2025. September tuition must be paid by check or exact cash. We are unable to use this years auto-withdrawal information due to the difference in price.

Kindergarten Registration

For those students who are moving on to Kindergarten. Registration has opened in both Lake Washington School District (LWSD) and Northshore School District (NSD). You can enroll your child for Kindergarten on the district websites. Enrolling now connects you with the school community and keeps you up to date with matters happening with your school.


Tuition Tax Receipts

It has come to my attention that there has been some harm done in the Memorial area, located at the far south end of the school grounds behind the playground. This area is where parishioners of Holy Cross place the ashes of their loved ones to rest in the Memorial Garden Wall. The Memorial area features a water fountain, a bench, and a brick pathway leading to the wall. Many visitors leave flowers or plants, or simply take a moment to sit on the bench and reflect.

We kindly ask that all students and families respect this serene and peaceful area. You are welcome to walk the path, listen to the fountain, sit on the bench, and take in the tranquility. Please help us keep the Memorial area in good condition for everyone to enjoy.
