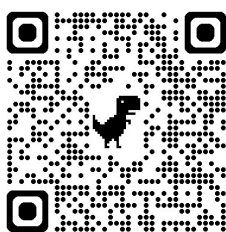

School Health

As we head into cold/flu season just a few reminders to help us stay healthy.

- Must be 24 hours fever, vomit, diarrhea free without use of medication to return to school.

Holidays

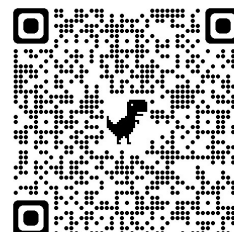
