#### **Current Student Registration**

#### Attention 3's Families: PreK Registration is Now Open!

Our PreK classes are now open for registration for our current 3's students. This is a great opportunity for your child to continue their preschool education with us and prepare for kindergarten.

The registration period starts on **January 13**. To secure your spot, please follow these steps by **January 29**.

- Fill out the **registration form** attached to this newsletter and choose your preferred class option (1st and 2nd choice).
- Submit the form along with the \$100 registration fee (non-refundable) to the office.
- If you have a PreK student who will be moving on to TK next year, please contact the office for a separate registration form.

For new families who are interested in joining our preschool, registration forms will be available on our website beginning January 13. New families can turn the form and fee in at anytime but we won't begin processing them until February 1. If you know of a family looking for a preschool please share our information.

## **Snow Policy**

A few reminders about our inclement weather policy as stated in the parent handbook and the flyer that went home in November.

- The safety of our students and staff is our primary concern.
- We don't make a final decision until 7:30am.
- Monitor our website, www.bestbeginningspreschool.com, and Facebook page. We will update those sites
  as soon as we make a decision.
- We monitor Northshore and Lake Washington school districts closure schedule, but don't always follow
  their closures or delays. If they are operating differently, be sure to check our website and Facebook
  page.
- We will offer make-up days for any closures beyond two missed class days.
- If at any time you don't feel comfortable driving, please stay home.

#### Reminders

A few reminders as we start back to school.

- Attendance check in needs to be completed each day prior to arrival.
- Classes go out to recess everyday, even in the rain. Please send your child to school with appropriate clothing for being outside.
- Please remember to contact the office, your teacher, or complete the attendance check in if your child is going to be absent for any reason. You can email @ office@bestbeginningspreschool.com or call 425-881-3468.
- Tuition is due by the 9th of each month. Automatic withdrawal payments will be deducted on the 5th or the closest business day.

Kindergarten registration usually begins in February. Be sure to check with your home school to see when registration begins. You can also check your districts website for registration events.






# **Late Pick Up Policy**

Parents are expected to pick up their students on time each day. We understand that real life circumstances sometimes interfere and picking up on time is delayed. If you are running late we appreciate a phone call to the school at 425-881-3468 letting us know that you are on your way and running late. Young children become upset when they do not see their grown-up at pick up.

It is important to remember that we are a part time preschool and teachers are only contracted for a short time after school. Out of respect for our teacher's time, families with repeated instances of late pick up will be assessed a late fee of \$2 per minute (after a 5-minute grace period). The late fee must be paid at pick-up.

To alleviate any stress about running late for pick-up it is a good idea to have someone in your child's class or another class that you feel comfortable keeping an eye on your child until you arrive.
