Get ready for an exciting new year at our school! We're happy to announce that registration for the 2025/2026 school year will begin in January. Please watch for registration information for current families to come home in bags and backpacks in January.

#### **Alumni Incoming 3's**

Do you have a 3 or almost 3 year old at home? The registration form for our alumni families with incoming 3 year old for the 2025-2026 school year is now available on our website, https://bestbeginningspreschool.com.

Registration forms and the non-refundable \$100 registration fee will be accepted starting January 6th. 2025.

#### **Current 3's Class Students**

Registration for students currently enrolled in our 3's classes moving on to our PreK classes will begin on January 13th. Forms will go home in your 3's students bag on January 8th and 9th.

Registration forms and the non-refundable \$100 registration fee are due by January 29th to be considered for alumni placement. On February 3 registration opens up to new students and we can not guarantee your class selection.

#### **Transitional Kindergarten 2024/2025**

Students who are currently enrolled in our PreK classes, do not make the district birthdate cut off, have had a year in a 4's preschool class, and will turn 5 by 12/31/24, will begin registration on January 13th. Registration forms and the non-refundable \$100 registration fee must be submitted by January 29th to be considered for placement. On February 3 we open up registration to new students. Talk with your child's teacher if you are unsure about registering for TK or sending your child to kindergarten.

Most people can donate...it's easy after a good meal, hydration to meet the needs of your community. Honor a family member that might have needed blood in the past.


