# 2022-2023 Registration

## **Alumni Incoming 3's**

This month we will take class requests from alumni with incoming 3 year old's (children not currently enrolled in our 3's or 4's) for Fall 2022.

If you have a child who will turn 3 by 8/31/22 and would like to be added to our class request list please contact the school office at 425-881-3468, or by email at hc.preschool@frontier.com. Alumni forms for incoming 3's will be up on our website starting December 13th. Registration forms and the non-refundable \$100 registration fee will be accepted starting January 5th.

## **Current 3's Class Students**

Registration for students currently enrolled in our 3's classes moving on to our PreK classes will begin on January 5th. Forms will go home in students bags on January 3th and 4th.

Registration forms and the nonrefundable \$100 registration fee are due by January 28th to be considered for placement. After January 28th registration opens up to new students and we can not guarantee your class selection.

## **Transitional Kindergarten**

Students who are currently enrolled in our PreK classes, do not make the district birthdate cut off, have had a year in a 4's preschool class, and will turn 5 by 12/31/22, will begin registration on January 5th. Registration forms and the non-refundable \$100 registration fee must be submitted by January 28th to be considered for placement. After January 28th we open up registration to new students.





It is the time of year to review the snow plan because it almost always catches us by surprise. The safety of our staff and students is our priority when making the decision to open/close or run a delayed schedule. We do not follow Northshore or Lake Washington School Districts decision. Public schools need to make any scheduling decisions by 5am due to busing and earlier start times. We will make our decision by 7am. This will allow us some extra time to evaluate road and driving conditions. As stated in the handbook, we allow each class to miss 2 sessions after which point, we will adjust our calendar making up the lost time at the end of the school year.

#### Keep in mind....

- An open, close or running late decision will be made around 7:00AM.
- Please do not call the school! No one will be there.
- Check the school website and our Facebook page for any changes to our schedule. Scan the QR Code to take you to our website.
- Teachers will email information as soon as they hear from the Director, which will be after 7:00am.
- If a fair amount of snow has come down and either Lake Washington or Northshore School Districts are running on emergency schedules, then we most likely will be doing somethings different as well.
- If snow starts falling during the school day, make your way back to school and pick up your child so that everyone can get home safely.
