SAFETY PROTOCOLS & PROCEDURES

Certainly, many of us have our own feelings about our individual freedoms. It certainly is the hallmark of our constitutional rights. However, we need to make sure that we are ALL safe and protecting each other from outside pathogens. As such, summer camp is the place to put our best foot forward. Please join us as we fulfill the recommendations made for us by our governing bodies.

SAFETY PROCEDURES & PROTOCOLS

The safety protocols and procedures that we are following are mandated by numerous governing organizations including but not limited to CDC, WHO, TEA, UIL and the State of Texas.

These procedures and protocols are REQUIRED to protect all participants involved and are mandatory! Anyone not following these procedures and protocols will be dismissed and there will be no refunds.

SOCIAL DISTANCING is always REQUIRED!

All students must remain in their respective dance space! All spots will be marked off by the staff before the students arrive. All spaces will be marked off at 12' x 12' squares with aisles to separate. There will be a 15-foot aisle between the participants and the facilitator.

FACE MASKS are REQUIRED at all time!

You will need to bring your own mask decorated with your take on the rainbows, prismatic rainbow background and the theme, RISE or Together We Will Rise! You will find art files attached to your email for your use.

FACE SHIELDS are required during workshops and round tables!

HTEDance Safety Team will provide each participant with a face shield. Feel free to bring arts & crafts items to decorate the shield that we provide!

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CLEANING & DISINFECTING PROCEDURES

In compliance with the recommendations from UIL, we will be cleaning and disinfecting the dance spaces after each class. ALL STUDENTS are required to bring their own hand sanitizer and can of disinfectant such as Lysol or equivalent.

CLASS SIZE LIMITATIONS AND RATIOS

In response to UIL's mandate of 1:20 staff to student ratio mandate, we will be maintaining a 1:10 staff to student ratio throughout the event.

We will have no more than 50 students in each ballroom. All participants MUST practice social distancing rules and protocols.

FOOD DELIVERY

HTEDance recognizes the importance of safety in food delivery at camp. As such, any food will be delivered to the student in their dance square. After eating, all refuse and remaining items from the meal box, must be returned to the meal box and reclosed. Staff will pick up the used boxes.

WATER

All students are required to bring a water thermos, bottle, or jug with them. The hotel will be providing sealed bags of ice for each student. The student is encouraged to bring their own bottled water. Bottled water is available for sale at the hotel shop and will be available at the HTEDance Snak-Shak.

CONNECTABILITY

At HTEDance, we are known for bringing people together. Helping teams and squads to maximize their potential! In doing so, our schedule of events tends to involve people in VERY close connection to one another. While we love this aspect of our job, we recognize the needs to exercise extreme caution this year. As such, you will find many differences in this years schedule designed to maximize safety for all participant!
