We are happy to share the wonderful experience at the Bhumi Campus Awards 2025 held on 6th December in Delhi.

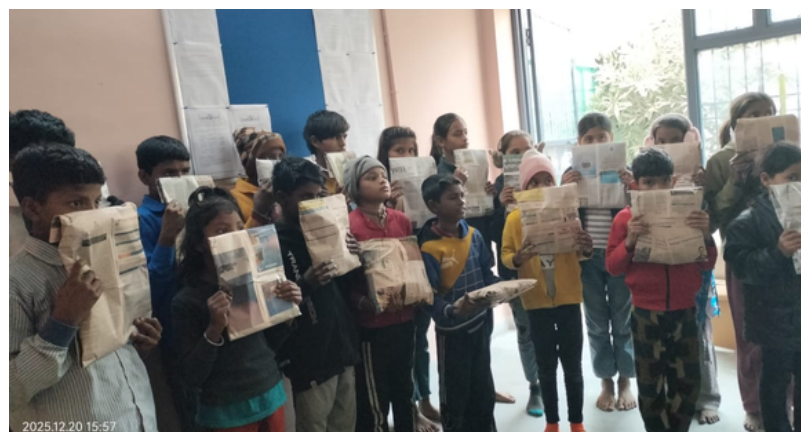

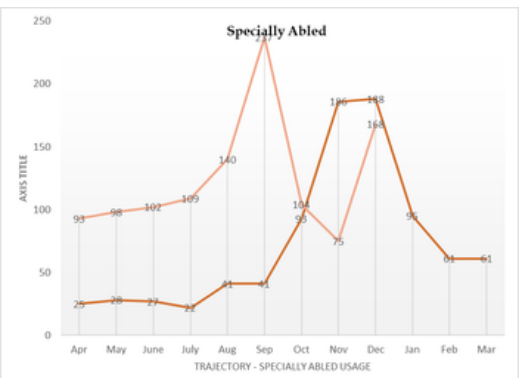
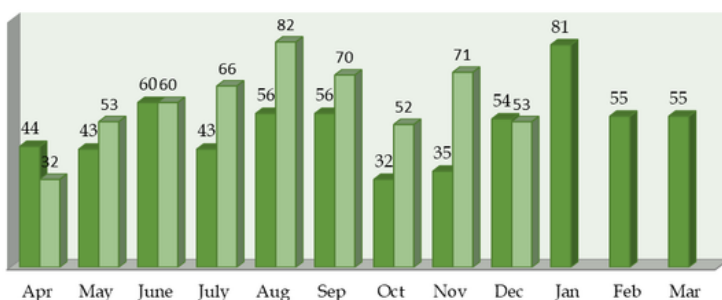
