300 community women at Garima Grih received their certificates upon completing skilling courses like Computer Literacy, Stitching and Tailoring, and Beauty & Wellness. In collaboration with Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) as infrastructure partner & READ INDIA as its skilling partner, PVR NEST is empowering these women with skills that make them market-ready, enabling them to lead dignified and enriching lives



PVR NEST's public health infrastructure facility, 'Garima Grih' at Kirti Nagar, New Delhi in association with the Municipal Corporation of Delhi has been acknowledged by Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) 2.0 of Ministry of Housing and Government Affairs, Government of India for operating as a multi-utility centre for women run by women showcasing the government's initiative supporting women. Ms. Ekta Gupta, official in Department of Environment Management Services (DEMS), Municipal Corporation of Delhi visited Garima Grih and was impressed with the facilities of the multi-utility safe sanitation complex for migrant communities in Delhi's slums working actively towards empowerment of community women.







# LEARNING TO EMBRACE A HEALTHIER LIFESTYLE

Dr. Surjit Gupta from Read India conducted two health awareness workshops. The one on metrics on the growth pattern monitoring a child's height and weight with age conveys essential information about their health and developmental progress with a deviation indicating an issue that requires attention. The second was on common health issues arising out of lack of physical activity, poor dietary habits leading to obesity, tobacco and substance abuse, AIDS, mental health conditions. Addressing these, enhances the overall quality of life and disease-free well-being. A total of 84 members of the community attended these sessions.

10th grader Chandni stitched her own suit and a blouse for her mother. Enrolling for the course has not only served as a source of income but has also fuelled her aspiration to open her own boutique.

Skilling programs tap users of sanitation facilities at Pink Centres and Garima Grih, spurring steady growth and raising community aspirations for learning new skills.



## **UPGRADING PINK CENTRES AT R.K. PURAM AND VASANT VIHAR**

Addressing the prevailing infrastructure challenges of Pink Centres is crucial for fostering a more inclusive and secure environment. This involves ensuring accessibility for all, prioritizing the safety of women, incorporating child-friendly facilities, providing adequate handwashing areas and clear toilet signages, and ensuring suitable seating for both users and attendants. Additional considerations encompass provision of storage rooms, menstrual hygiene tools like incinerators and sanitary napkin vending machines. MCD officials visited the Pink Centres at R.K. Puram and Vasant Vihar and have accepted PVR NEST recommendations for making infrastructural changes. This includes carving out an activity room for women from the non-operational men's toilet, creating more space for conducting activities, adding a PWD toilet.




# SAFE CENTRES CREATE LASTING CHANGES IN COMMUNITIES




The usage of the Pink Centre is assessed based on visitation numbers. In Gaffar Market, which comprises only 2 units, draws footfall equivalent to 18% of the total footfalls of 10 Pink Centres. Among the users, over 55% are young girls who utilize the facility, drawn to the sense of security and hygienic environment these centres provide.

#### SHAPING SKILLS FOR LIFF LONG LEARNING



The newspaper reading program is transforming into a routine among community members. The shift in behavior is evident in the universal demand for newspapers throughout the day by visitors of all ages, including children, young girls, and ladies accessing various facilities at Garima Grih.

### Safe Centre User Analysis



The youth demographic accessing the center constitutes 42% of the total user base. Access to the secure and hygienic facility has not only enhanced their health but has also motivated them to enroll in various skill development courses offered at Safe Centers. The inclusive character of the Safe Centers is evident in the utilization by 112+ individuals with disabilities and 82 transpersons, who utilize the facility for personal hygiene and safety.
