Proposed Bylaw Amendment

Current Form

ARTICLE VI: MEETINGS AND QUORUMS § SECTION 1

§ The regular business meeting of the Auxiliary shall be held on the first Monday of April, June, September, December, February and March, except for dates when the dining room is unavailable at the lodge, and therefore a different date will be selected. Dates also may vary in winter months due to weather.

Proposed Form

ARTICLE VI: MEETINGS AND QUORUMS § SECTION 1

§ The regular business meeting of the Auxiliary shall be held on the first Monday of each month, except for July and August. Dates may occasionally change due to holidays or when the banquet room at the Lodge is unavailable, and therefore a different date will be selected. Dates may also vary in winter months due to weather.

Rationale: Currently the Auxiliary does not meet from September through February. There are several important programs during this time, including the distribution and selling of lottery tickets, decorating the banquet room, and wrapping Angel Tree gifts. Holding meetings during these months would allow for better communication with the members and would help all programs run smoother.
