Did you know about the Saints: On November 9, we celebrate the dedication of the Basilica Saint John Lateran which is one of the four major Basilicas located in Rome and has the official name, Archbasilica of the Most Holy Savior and Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist. The other three Basilicas are Saint Peter's, Saint Mary Major, and Saint Paul Outside the Walls. The feast day for the dedication of this basilica was initiated in 1726 by Pope Benedict XIII to remind all Catholics that they are united through the Universal Church with the Pope as our Pastor. Six Papal tombs, the skulls of Saints Peter and Paul, the table of Saint Peter, and other relics are located in this basilica. Saint John Lateran is the Cathedral for all Catholics throughout the world. All Holy Men and Woman, Pray for us.

Pastor's Note: Dwelling place of God....

This Sunday we celebrate the dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. This Basilica is the official Cathedral Church of Rome and the official ecclesiastical seat of the Pope, as the Bishop of Rome. It is known as the mother church of Roman Catholicism worldwide. This is why the feast we celebrate today represents the feast of all the churches in the world. When we enter a church, we feel the presence of God, and we spend time conversing with God and experience the comfort of being in God's company. Being omnipresent, God is present everywhere, but we feel his presence in an intense way, while we are in a church. Thus, a church represents the abiding presence of God. This is also a celebration of the universality of the church and the unity of the church as the body of Christ. The Pope, being the head of the church, leads us to experience and to bear witness to the presence of Christ in the world. All the readings today present the church (temple) as the dwelling place of God, which is able to transform the lives of its believers. In the first reading, an extract from the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah, we hear the transformative power of the grace flowing from the temple. In this reading, water represents the grace of God, which is able to refresh and give life to the whole world. This concept of God in our midst is summarized in the Responsorial Psalm, "The waters of the river gladden the city of God, the holy dwelling of the Most High!" In the Gospel, we see Jesus cleansing the temple of Jerusalem, then considered the dwelling place of God, by the Jewish people. He drives away those desecrating the temple with their abuse of its premises, by using them for their selfish gains. In the second reading, we have Paul reminding us that the temple of God has to be kept holy, and here he reminds us that the real dwelling place of God is in each of us. We are temples of the Holy Spirit and, thus, have to live as worthy places of his dwelling.
