Did you know about the Saints: On May 30th, we celebrate the Feast of Saint Joan of Arc (1412–1431). Joan of Arc was born in Domremy-Greux located south-east of Paris, France. As a teenager she experienced visions of Saint Michael the Archangel, Saint Catherine of Alexandra, and Saint Margaret of Antioch. Joan participated in the 100 Years War and strove to remove the English from French Territory but was eventually captured and tried as a heretic. During the trial, Joan was asked if she knew if she was in God's grace. Her reply was simple, "If I am not, may God put me there; and if I am, may God so keep me." Joan of Arc was burned to death after the unfair trial. Pope Benedict the XV canonized her in 1920. She is the patron Saint of France. May we have an incorruptible trust and fervor in God just as this great Saint. Saint Joan of Arc, pray for us!

We must lovingly safeguard the grandeur of humanity bestowed upon us and revealed in its fullness in Christ, the splendor of which no machine can ever replace.

Pastor's Note: God of communion....

Having completed the Season of Easter and celebrated the gift of the Holy Spirit, this Sunday we rejoice with the Church as we glorify our triune God. During the Holy Week and through the Easter Season, we have been reflecting on the commitment and love of Jesus Christ. We also meditated on how God the Father was instrumental in guiding the events that occurred, and how the Resurrection of Jesus was a mark of approval and reward for the commitment of Jesus, by his Father. All through the Season of Easter, we heard how Jesus was going to send us the Spirit of God, the paraclete (one called alongside to help), even as he was departing to be with his Father in heaven. Last week we celebrated the arrival of the Holy Spirit, and we saw how this gift from above strengthened and transformed the Apostles and all the other disciples. What was evident in all these celebrations was that there was a communion between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, who worked together to transform our lives. This Sunday, what we celebrate is this existence of our God as a reality of mutual and perfect love. There is only one God, and yet the three persons we celebrate in this God, as Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, have distinct roles to play, to bring to fulfillment the vision they have for the human race. The first reading presents the encounter of Moses with God, who describes himself as a gracious and merciful God, who is slow to anger and rich in kindness. We glorify this God through our Responsorial Psalm today. In the second reading, Paul encourages us to remain united, and he concludes with a trinitarian blessing, which we use in our Eucharist every day. In the Gospel we are reminded that Jesus was sent by God to redeem the world through him. This, again, is an expression of the unitary action of God that is visible in the ministry of Jesus, who perfectly carried out the will of his Father, revealing their communion.
