Upon entering a little country store, the stranger noticed a sign warning, "Danger! Beware of dog!" posted on the glass door. Inside, he noticed a harmless old hound dog asleep on the floor beside the cash register.

"Is that the dog folks are supposed to beware of?" he asked the owner.

"Yep, that's him," came the reply.

The stranger couldn't help but be amused. "That certainly doesn't look like a dangerous dog to me. Why in the world would you post that sign?"

"Because," the owner explained, "Before I posted that sign, people kept tripping over him."

Pastor's Note:

A leadership rooted in and inspired by God... Servant-leadership is something that Jesus himself demonstrated in his lifetime. Jesus is inviting all of us to be servants of his mission, especially when we are entrusted with the responsibility of caring for people, either as parents, leaders, teachers or ministers. Leadership is about caring for the needs of the people, and this becomes an easy task when we have the wisdom of God to guide us. The first reading presents the failed leadership of king Shebna, who used his position of authority to exploit the people and to enrich himself, rather than the people. God, through Prophet Isaiah, warns him and removes him from his seat of power and elevates Eliakim to be the King. Because he did not follow the counsel of the Lord, he failed in his duties. And in the Gospel passage, we see Peter professes Jesus to be the Messiah, and Jesus stresses that the power of God is what enabled him to make this confession. And since he is being led by the Spirit of God, he is entrusted with the task of leading others in the name of God. Peter becomes the leader of the flock and the one who is able to lead the people in the path of Christ. He is given the authority to let people in, and to shut the doors on people who are not worthy. This in no way negates the desire of God to save everyone. The leadership role that Peter is urged to play will have to draw its inspiration from the kind of generosity and compassion Jesus showed during his life on earth. Jesus was looking for ways and means to shower the mercy and love of God on people. Even the so-called sinners were invited to his party. It is this compassionate wisdom of God that has to influence every decision making by his servant leaders.
