Did you know about the Saints: On January 27, we celebrate the feast of **Saint Angela Merici** (1474 - 1540). Angela was an orphan who joined the third order Franciscans as a teenager. During a pilgrimage to the Holy Land, she was struck with blindness but continued her trip to pray at many shrines. Her sight was later restored when she was praying before a crucifix. Angela utilized her talents to teach and educate children and was eventually joined by other devout women. Her mission was to bring order to society and to families through education. After Angela’s death, the group of women continued and eventually organized into the Order of Saint Ursula. Today this group maintains the mission of Angela by teaching young woman in 30 different countries and are known by many as the Ursuline nuns. Angela Merici was canonized by Pope Pius VII in 1807. Angela Merici, pray for us!
