This quote by the noted German Theologian is one of my favorites and one by which I try to live my life. Praying can be difficult. It can be hard to find the words to express yourself, especially for people who are not used to expressing themselves. Likewise, the thought of speaking directly to God can be intimidating. What if I say the wrong thing? What if I leave something out? Of course, people also often feel like they are intruding on God and don't want to bother him. So, if you're ever unsure of how to pray or what to pray, just try praying, "Thank you".

As we enter into a season of thanksgiving, I invite you to remember what the scriptures say about thankfulness:

Offer to God the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and pay your vows to the Most High. Psalm 50:14

Bless, give thanks, and gratefully praise God in full congregations, even the Lord, O you who are from [Jacob] the fountain of Israel. Psalm 68: 26

These words of the Psalmists remind us that God delights in us, and blesses us daily. It is right for us to be thankful, but giving thanks, in and of itself, is for our benefit as well. When we give thanks, we give what is due, and we are reminded that we exist because of incredible generosity. This turns our outlook away from ourselves and onto God and to others who have blessed us as well. When this happens, we are drawn out of soul destroying selfishness and recognize how much we need God and others. This in turn should inspire us to be a blessing to others, to give unto others as God has given unto us.

Parents work incredibly hard to teach their children to say please and thank you, and we call these things niceties, but that is not a strong enough name for them.

Given that when Jesus healed ten lepers only the one who returned to give thanks to Jesus was given his full blessing, maybe we should refer to thankfulness as a necessity rather than a nicety.
