Memorial Brick Garden Laser-Engraved Bricks

The deadline to order new Memorial Garden bricks is September 7. Bricks in the Memorial Garden are Regimental Red in color and 4" x 8" x 2½" in size. The first line of text on each brick reads "In Honor" or "In Memory." Two additional lines of text can be engraved with up to 20 characters per line (including punctuation and spacing).

The letters of text are 15 mm tall and engraved in the Zapt Humnst font. One clipart can be used on each brick and is included in the cost of the brick.

The 4"x8" bricks will be \$40.00 each. Keepsake Mini Replica bricks are also available for purchase. The mini replicas will not be placed in the Memorial Garden but are ones that you may want to have for your home. Please see the sales flyer for more information and pricing.
