Covenant

We believe that a young person is not the only one affected by his/her camp experience. As campers are commissioned during worship, the "camp seed" is planted in younger children; they can't wait for the time when it will be their turn to go to camp. Youth are encouraged to give camp a try when they hear the camp stories of their peers. Folks beyond camping age may be inspired to become camp counselors or to donate money or supplies to Camp Laurelview. Everyone at Fairhill Manor catches a bit of the "mountaintop" excitement for living the faith that our young people bring home with them from an experience at camp.

We covenant to support and pray for you throughout your camp experience. We ask that you covenant to share your camp experience with the rest of the congregation in these ways:

- 1. I will participate in a commissioning service during worship on the Sunday of my departure for camp. If I cannot be present on that Sunday, I will make arrangements with one of the Pastors to be commissioned on another Sunday.
- 2. Upon my return from Camp Laurelview, I will share my camp experience and how it impacted me by writing a brief summary, making a drawing or painting, etc. and submitting it to the church office by August 15 for publication in the church's September newsletter.
