Many years ago, I went to the Mattress Factory, which is a modern art museum on Pittsburgh's north side. I like modern art museums even though it is true that many of the paintings in a modern art museum look like something that your child could have done on a bad day in kindergarten. What they lack in technique they more than make up for by experience.

My favorite experience at the Mattress Factory, however, was not one the artist had intended. There was a piece entitled, "Pleiades" which was a room that was

completely ensconced in darkness. As my wife, my friend, and I entered the room we could not see our hand in front of our face, and we walked--slowly—up a ramp until we got to a platform. We could feel that there were two chairs, three walls, and four people on this platform. The instructions told us to wait for twenty minutes for our eyes to adjust, and we would experience "the intersection of the inner seeing with the outer seeing."

And so, we waited. Silently. Patiently. Then it happened. A sound came from outside the room. It was four more people stumbling blindly up the ramp crashing into the others on the crowded ramp. I could not see anything. I could only hear the bumps and the groans; the cries from one man who said, "There's someone here"; the response from a woman, "Did you hit a wall"; and the whimper of a young girl, "I'm scared". I couldn't see any of the people around me, but I could feel them pressing me against the wall, staring in the dark, waiting for something to happen.

Again, it became silent, again we waited, and again it happened. Three girls waiting to come in, and not realizing how close we were to them, began a conversation about the Chinese food they were going to eat when they were done. After five minutes of this whatever peaceful, transcendent, moment I experienced was ruined. Finally, it settled down again, and we heard somewhere in the dark these fateful words. "Julia? Are you ready?" "Yeah" "I don't get it . . .maybe I'm stupid." "Let's go". We followed right after wishing that we could have had that twenty minutes back When we got out, we discovered that we had only been in there a little over ten minutes and the sign around the corner instructed that only two were to be there at a time. I wonder what we might have experienced if we had waited the full time and done as we were supposed to do.

In a way I felt like that experience was a lot like the experience of Lent. We struggle through it in the heart of winter. We confess our sins and refrain from overindulgence, and in the middle of it we may say, "For what?", "I don't get it", "I'm ready to go". How many people have missed out on the light of the resurrection because they gave up in the dark of Lent? Stick with it, for God will neither disappoint nor abandon us to nothingness. God's way may not always make sense, and we may not always "get it" when were in the middle of it, but when all is revealed to us it will be the greatest experience of all.


