We will use a video conferencing tool called **Zoom** to gather for worship:

- On your computer, go to <a href="www.zoom.us">www.zoom.us</a>. Choose to "Join a Meeting." Enter the Meeting ID. You will be prompted to download Zoom next. Once Zoom is open, enter the Password.
- On your smartphone, download the Zoom app. Enter the Meeting ID and Password.
- On any device, click on this link: https://zoom.us/j/93245574206?pwd=cHdQMmlPWURmWkdqQUZmRXIMeGdudz09
- From any phone, dial (646) 876-9923 to join by audio only. Enter the Meeting ID, followed by #. When asked for a Participant ID, just press # to continue. Enter the Password, followed by #.

## How to prepare for our Worship time on Zoom:

- Try out Zoom <u>before</u> Sunday. Email (<u>genasheller@msn.com</u>) or text (724-263-0033) Pastor Gena if you would like to test your connection ahead of time. Once worship begins, our worship leaders will focus on leading worship for those present.
- The Zoom space will be open for you to join at 12 pm, 30 minutes prior to the start of Worship at 12:30 pm. Use this half hour to chat and catch up with others.
- If you choose to participate with video (so that others can see you), please locate yourself in an appropriate place with minimal background movement and few distractions. Ensure that the camera part of your device is at eye level and 2-3 feet from your face. If you are not comfortable being seen, you can join by audio only.
- Explore how to mute and unmute your microphone. <u>Please keep your microphone muted</u> <u>unless you are speaking</u>. The video display will follow whomever is talking or making noise, so muting our microphones will allow the video to stay focused on the person leading worship.
- It is best for everyone in one location to share one device. Using more than one device close together causes echoing and squealing.
- Please do not take screenshots without asking permission first and letting folks know where you plan to share the photo.
- Once worship begins, do your best to focus on worship. Place your cell phone on mute. Let friends and family know that you will be in worship during this time.

We invite you to gather items for **Communion** prior to worship. Prepare something that can be broken and shared (e.g., bread, a cracker) and a glass of juice or another beverage.
