AN ACT to prohibit a government entity from requiring individuals to receive a COVID-19 vaccine

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, regulation
- 2 or executive order to the contrary, no state or local government entity,
- 3 or its political subdivisions, agents, or assigns, shall be permitted to
- 4 require any individual to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.
- 5 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
