

2020 Texas Property Tax Calendar

January 2020

January 1^{st} – Date that current year taxable values and exemptions are determined (except for some inventories appraised as of September 1^{st}).

February 2020

February 1st – The date that the previous year's taxes become delinquent if unpaid.

April 2020

April 1st – The last day for property owners to files renditions unless they file an extension.

April 30th – Last day for property owners to file applications or certain reports with the CAD including:

- Certain exemption applications.
- Notice to the Chief Appraiser that property no longer entitled to an exemption that does not require an annual application.
- Applications for special appraisal or notices to the Chief Appraiser that property no longer qualifies for: 1-d or 1-d-1 agricultural appraisal, open space, recreational park and scenic land, and public access airport property.
- Railroad rolling stock reports Request for separate listings of separately owned property (undivided interest properties).
- Requests for proportionate taxation of a planned unit development.

May 2020

May 15th – Last day to file a protest with the ARB for the current year (or 30 days after the notice was mailed, whichever is later).

May 31st – Last day for taxing units to file challenges with the ARB (or within 15 days after the ARB receives the appraisal records, whichever is later).

July 2020

July 25th – Date that the Chief Appraiser should certify the appraisal roll to the taxing jurisdictions.

September 2020

September 1^{st} – Alternate date for the appraisal of inventory if applied for by the property owner and granted by the Chief Appraiser.
