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What is Memory Care?

Memory care is specialized 24-hour care for individuals with Alzheimer's disease, dementia, and memory-related conditions. These secure communities have specially trained staff and environments designed to support cognitive challenges.

How Memory Care Differs from Assisted Living

Feature	Assisted Living	Memory Care
Security	Open environment	Secured to prevent wandering
Staff Training	General care	Dementia specialized
Staffing	Moderate ratios	Higher staffing levels
Average Cost	\$4,500-6,500/mo	\$5,500-8,000/mo

Is It Time for Memory Care?

Warning Signs

Safety Concerns:

- Wandering from home or getting lost
- Leaving stove/appliances on
- Forgetting medications
- Frequent falls

Caregiver Burnout:

- Primary caregiver exhausted
- 24-hour supervision needed
- Caregiver's health suffering

Behavioral Changes:

- Increased aggression or anxiety
- Severe sundowning
- Resisting care from family

Daily Living Challenges:

- Cannot bathe, dress, or toilet independently
- Forgetting to eat or drink
- Incontinence unmanageable at home

Austin Memory Care Costs (2025)

Central Austin: \$7,000-12,000/month (avg \$8,500)

North Austin: \$5,500-8,000/month (avg \$6,500)

South Austin: \$5,000-7,500/month (avg \$6,000)

West Austin: \$6,500-10,000/month (avg \$7,500)

What's Typically Included

- Room and board
- Three meals daily plus snacks
- 24-hour staffing and supervision
- Medication management
- Housekeeping and laundry
- All activities and programming

Payment Options

1. Private Pay: Personal savings, home equity, retirement accounts

2. Long-Term Care Insurance: Check your policy - many cover memory care

3. Veterans Benefits (Aid & Attendance):

- Veteran alone: Up to \$2,295/month
- Veteran with spouse: Up to \$2,713/month
- Surviving spouse: Up to \$1,474/month

4. Medicaid: Limited options in Austin - most memory care communities do not accept Medicaid

Top 10 Questions to Ask During Tours

1. What is your staff-to-resident ratio?

Look for 1:6 or better during day, 1:10 or better at night

2. What specialized dementia training does staff receive?

Look for specific programs like Positive Approach to Care

3. How do you prevent wandering?

Look for multiple safety systems, not just locked doors

4. Can residents age in place here?

Look for hospice partnerships and ability to care through disease progression

5. What is your staff turnover rate?

Look for under 30% annually

6. How are activities tailored to different cognitive levels?

Look for small groups and modified activities

7. What additional costs should we expect?

Get specific details about level-of-care fees

8. What is your visitation policy?

Look for open visitation, 24/7 access

9. How do you keep families informed?

Look for regular updates and care conferences

10. Can I speak with families of current residents?

Red flag if they're unwilling to provide references
