NOMINATION PETITIONS <u>MUST</u> BE COPIED AS <u>DUPLEX</u> (TWO-SIDED, FRONT AND BACK, HEAD TO HEAD) ON **PLAIN WHITE** 8 1/2 X 11" (LETTER SIZE) PAPER. THIS REQUIREMENT <u>CANNOT</u> BE SATISFIED BY PRINTING EACH SIDE OF THE DUPLEX NOMINATION PETITION ON A SEPARATE SHEET OF 8 1/2 x 11" PAPER AND AFFIXING THE TWO SHEETS TOGETHER WITH A STAPLE OR PAPER CLIP.

### FAILURE TO REPRODUCE THE NOMINATION PETITION FORMS CORRECTLY WILL RESULT IN THE REJECTION OF THOSE FORMS!

**All blank lines**, which appear on the front of each nomination petition, must be completed **BEFORE** signatures are obtained. The following instructions correspond with the blank lines found on the nomination petition:

### 1 ELECTORAL DISTRICT

Write the name of the "Electoral District" in which the candidate is running. The Electoral District should be written to include municipality and/or election district or Schuylkill County as the case may be; for example:

If you are a candidate for a county-wide office insert "Schuylkill County". County wide offices include; County Commissioner, District Attorney, Sheriff, Clerk of Courts, Register of Wills and Clerk of the Orphans Court Division, Recorder of Deeds, County Treasurer, County Controller, Prothonotary and Coroner

If you are a candidate for a city/township/borough-wide office; such as Mayor, Council, Supervisor, Auditor or Tax Collector insert the name of the municipality or township in which you are running then insert Schuylkill County.

Examples: City of Pottsville, Schuylkill County

Norwegian Township, Schuylkill County Tamaqua Borough, Schuylkill County

If you are a candidate for a municipal office that is elected less than a municipality-wide (such as for Judge of Election, Inspector of Election or Party Committee Person), then also include the Precinct or District followed by Schuylkill County.

Examples: Minersville Borough 3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct, Schuylkill County

North Union Township, 116th District, Schuylkill County

## NOMINATION PETITIONS INSTRUCTIONS – CONT.

#### **2** POLITICAL PARTY

Enter the candidate's political party ("Democratic" or "Republican").

### **3** NAME OF CANDIDATE

Type or print the name of the candidate **EXACTLY** as the candidate would like it to appear on the ballot. Candidates who wish to use nicknames, other than a derivative of their legal given name, must obtain, complete and file an *Affidavit for Ballot Name Change* at the Schuylkill County Election Bureau and Voter Registration. (**Note:** The name change is based on how the candidate is known to the public, not on how he/she would like to be known.)

### 4 PROFESSION, BUSINESS, OR OCCUPATION

For "Profession, Business, or Occupation," write your current job title, such as "Attorney," "Clerk," "Accountant," "Business Manager," "Secretary," or "Warehouse Worker." Simply putting initials such as VP, CEO, COO, CFO is not sufficient. (**Note:** Retired is an acceptable entry in this line.)

#### **5** PLACE OF RESIDENCE

Enter your house number (apartment number, if applicable), street name and ZIP Code.

#### **6** TITLE OF OFFICE

For "Title of Office" include the office for which you are seeking election. For 2025, those offices are one of the following: Magisterial District Judge, District Attorney, Sheriff, Mayor, City Council, Borough Council, Township Supervisor, Tax Collector, Auditor, School Board Director, Judge of Election, Inspector of Election, Party Committee Person.

### **TERM OF OFFICE**

For "Term of Office" insert: 2 Year Term, 4 Year Term or 6 Year Term.

### **Filing the Nomination Petition**

#### **Sheet Numbers**

If you are submitting more than one sheet of petition signatures, fill in the sheet numbers in the bottom right corner; and number the pages consecutively.

#### Where to File Completed Petition Packages

To submit completed petitions and all other necessary materials that must be filed, you can mail or deliver them to our office at:

## NOMINATION PETITIONS COLLECTING SIGNATURES – CONT.

- ✓ <u>DO NOT</u> begin to collect signatures before Tuesday, February 18, 2025....this would be considered a fatal flaw
- ✓ DO NOT use old Petitions, they have changed since the last Municipal Election
- ✓ Signers must be registered to vote (you can not register them and have them sign at the same time, registration must first be processed by the Voter Registration office)
- ✓ Signers must be from the political party that you are registered in and seeking the nomination for
- ✓ They must live and be registered in the municipality or school district (and ward, district, or region where applicable) you are running in

## NOMINATION PETITIONS COLLECTING SIGNATURES – CONT.

- ✓ Signers must fill out the entire line for themselves
- ✓ Signers can only sign as many petitions as there are offices up for election
- ✓ <u>Signature of Elector:</u> Should be as they are registered Check your street list if they do not know how they are registered
- ✓ <u>Printed Name of Elector:</u> <u>PRINT</u> name as signed and registered
- ✓ Place of Residence: Where you live
  - House number: 911/physical number of your house
  - > Street or Road: 911 / Physical name of road you live on
  - City, Township, Borough: NOT the mailing city.....this is the municipality that you live in
- ✓ <u>Date of Signing:</u> Date at time of signing

## NOMINATION PETITIONS COLLECTING SIGNATURES – CONT

- Signature requirements vary by office, please see the "Offices up for Election 2025 - Signature Requirements and Filing Fee" handout in your petition packet
- ONLY collect signatures between February 18, 2025 and March 11, 2025
- DO NOT use ditto (") marks
- ➤ If the signer makes a mistake, simply draw a single line through the entry. DO NOT use white out, erase, or completely black anything out on the petition
- Always try to get more than the required signatures, this will help safeguard your petition in the event that someone challenges the validity of the signatures

## NOMINATION PETITIONS STATEMENT OF CIRCULATOR

### PLEASE NOTE: THIS SECTION HAS CHANGED STATEMENT OF CIRCULATOR

- Most times it is the candidate that circulates their own petition
- Petitions can be circulated by someone else, however they must be a registered voter whose party affiliation matches the party for which the candidate is seeking nomination. They will be required to fill out this statement if that is the case (Exception: Magisterial District Judges)
- Only 1 (one) circulator per petition sheet
- School Board candidates can cross-file but <u>MUST</u> have someone from the <u>opposite party</u> circulate the petitions.....i.e. if the candidate is a Republican; a Republican must circulate the petition; to cross file and appear on the Democratic ballot, a Democrat must circulate the petition
- Magisterial District Judges can cross file, however their circulator do not need to follow party lines. For example: if the Magisterial District Judge candidate plans to cross file, they can circulate both the Democratic and the Republican petitions themselves. They do not need to have someone from the opposite party circulate the opposite petition.
- School Directors and Magisterial District Judges are the only office on the ballot this election cycle that can cross file
- This section of the petition no longer needs to be notarized, however, if someone other than the candidate circulates the petition, the circulator must fill out this section before you file your petition.
- Also new, circulators no longer need to live within the district of the
  candidate, but they <u>must</u> be registered in Schuylkill County. For example if the
  candidate is running for office in Norwegian Township their circulator can be
  from Pine Grove Township, or any other municipality within the County.

- The Statement of Circulator should <u>NOT</u> be filled out until <u>AFTER</u> you have gathered all signatures.
- "County of Petition Signers Residence" This should be in Schuylkill County
- "Signature of Circulator" Signature of person circulating petition. (Remember only 1 circulator per petition page)
- "Number and Street Address of Circulator" 911/Physical address (NO PO Boxes)
- 4. "Printed Name of Circulator" Name of person who circulated the petition, as registered
- 5. "City, Borough, or Township" Municipality that you are registered in i.e. Pottsville, Norwegian Township, Tamaqua Borough, Butler Township,
- 6. "Zip Code" The Circulators mailing zip code

# WAIVER OF EXPENSE AFFIDAVIT INSTRUCTIONS

Each candidate, which does not intend to form a Political Committee or to receive or to make expenditures in excess of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.) during any reporting period, along with the petitions with the required minimum number of signatures, must submit one *Waiver of Expense Affidavit* and must be signed by the candidate in front of a Notary Public, who will notarize the affidavit. On the Affidavit, the Candidate will complete the information in the right column and the **Notary Public** will complete the information in the left column.

### WAIVER OF EXPENSE AFFIDAVIT

#### WAIVER OF EXPENSE ACCOUNT REPORTING AFFIDAVIT

- Not required to be signed, however we <u>strongly</u> advise signing. If you choose not to sign you will be required to file Campaign Finance Reports for EVERY filing period
- To be completed by the candidate
- Split into two sections: Left side is for the notary, Right side is for the candidate
- ❖ "Signature of Candidate" **DO NOT** sign until in front of a notary

#### THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS CAN (AND SHOULD) BE FILLED OUT PRIOR TO NOTARIZATION

- "Printed Name of Candidate" Print name as registered, must match all other names on the petition
- "Street Address" 911/physical address of candidate (NO PO Boxes)
- "Post Office" city/town in your mailing address
- \* "City, Borough, or Township" Municipality in which you are registered i.e. City of Pottsville, Norwegian Township, Tamaqua Borough, Butler Township
- "County" Schuylkill
- "Election District of Candidate" This is the election district the candidate is running in i.e. if you are a candidate for school director you would put the name of the school district as well as the region/district
- "Telephone / Cell Phone Number"
- Judges of Election and Inspectors of Election are not required to file this affidavit and it is not part of their petition

## STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS

- Administered by the State Ethics Commission
- Used to disclose any potential conflicts of interest
- Original is filed with the secretary of the municipality, county, or school district in which you are running (<u>MUST</u> be filed by March 11, 2025)
- Copy <u>MUST</u> be filed with your nomination petition. (This is in <u>ADDITION</u> to your yearly filing if you are already in office)
- All information is for the "previous" year 2024
- Judges of Election and Inspectors of Election are NOT required to file this with their petition

- Filing fees MUST be paid when the Petition is filed
- Only Money Orders, Cash, or Certified Checks are accepted – NO Personal or Business checks.
   Money orders and Certified Checks can be made out to the Treasurer of Schuylkill County
- These fees are non-refundable



- Cross Filing means that you can run on both the Democratic and the Republican ballot
- During the 2025 Municipal Primary Election the only offices eligible to cross file are School Directors and Magisterial District Judge
- Requires 2 sets of petitions and all the required paper work
- School Directors <u>MUST</u> have someone from the opposite party circulate the petition for the opposite ballot
- Magisterial District Judges can have any party circulate any petition
- Signers MUST sign the petition for the party they are registered in – Republicans can not sign on the Democratic Petition and vice versa

OUR OFFICE <u>CAN NOT</u> GIVE YOU LEGAL OR FINANCIAL ADVICE



- If you or a political committee intend to spend or receive funds over \$250 in a <u>reporting</u> period, you must file a report, regardless of whether you signed the waiver or not.
- There are 4 reporting periods for candidates/committees: reports will be due in May, June, October, and December
- If you do not sign the Waiver of Expense you are required to file reports even if you do not spend or raise any funds.
- Penalties for overdue reports: \$20 for the first 6 days then \$10 per day after that up to a maximum of \$250
- If you sign the waiver and then form a committee, that negates the waiver and you MUST file campaign finance reports. Both the committee and the candidate must file separate reports.
- <u>ALL</u> reports during this Election Cycle are to be filed with the Schuylkill County Bureau of Election Office.

## POLITICAL COMMITTEES

- If you form a Committee, they MUST register with the Schuylkill County Election Office
- Every Committee must have a Treasurer and Chairperson
- Each Candidate/Committee shall keep records of the names and addresses of each person who contributes at least \$10
- Committees must be authorized by the Candidate
- ➤ If a Committee is formed Both the Committee and the Candidate must file a separate campaign finance report
- ➤ If a report is not filed in a timely matter for a Committee, the Treasurer is <u>personally</u> responsible for any and all late fees
- All campaign finance laws apply to Committees as well as Candidates

### WHAT TO KNOW...

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING
Be consistent when filling out your petition;
Example: Make sure your name is the same throughout the petition
Be consistent in the name of the office, the term
and the municipality
Please <u>PRINT NEATLY</u> or type your petition – it must be legible. This is where we get the information for the ballot
Each candidate is entitled to 1 free paper copy of street lists
Election office DOES NOT do specialized reports, however you can purchase a USB for \$20 and manipulate it any way needed (must be requested and paid for in advance)
Placement of political signs are regulated by the Municipalities not the Board of Elections

### WHAT TO KNOW...cont.

u	All Printed material must include a disclaimer i.e. Paid for by
	Election Bureau hours are 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday
	The Election Office does NOT have a Notary. Petitions must be notarized to be accepted at our office or they can be rejected
	File early to avoid long lines as we near the petition filing deadline
	Make sure everything is filled out <u>BEFORE</u> coming to the Election office to file your petition. This is the responsibility of the candidate <u>NOT</u> the Election office. If your paperwork is not complete you will be asked to step aside to complete your forms so that we can keep the lines moving. If you plan to mail your petitions in, please be sure that you have everything completed including the sections that need to be notarized. If they are incorrect they will be mailed back to you and could result in a late filing and rejection of your petition

### WHAT TO KNOW...cont.

- ☐ Please respond **PROMPTLY** to any and all correspondence received from the Election Bureau
- The Election Bureau will post on the Schuylkill County Website a sample ballot for review. Please notify us, whether or not the information is correct

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- I want to run for office, where do I start?
  - To get your name on the ballot you must circulate and file a petition. The first day to circulate petitions is normally around the middle of February and runs for 3 weeks.
- I was appointed to an elected position; does my name just automatically go on the ballot in the next Municipal Election?
  - No ones name "automatically" goes on the ballot. The <u>office</u> will go on the ballot i.e.: Member of Council – 4 year term.
- How much do I get paid?
  - Compensation varies by position School Board Directors do not get paid, Members of Council, Supervisors, Auditors, Mayors, etc. vary by Municipality. To find out if these positions are paid you must contact the municipality.
  - Tax Collectors are paid from the municipality, county, and school district therefore you need to contact them to find out the compensation.
- Someone gave me a petition that they had left over from a previous election, can I use it?
  - No, election laws and forms are always changing so please make sure that you have the most current forms available from our office. If you use an old form and it is missing required information, this could be a fatal flaw and an opponent could challenge the validity of your petition.
- Can more than 1 person circulate a single petition?
  - No, the circulator must sign a Statement of Circulator on the back of the
    petition and there is only room for 1 circulator. If you want more than 1
    person to circulate for you, give them a separate petition.
- Can I get my name on both the Democratic and Republican ballots?
  - Only Magisterial District Judge and School Directors can cross file.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - CONTINUED

- I am running for School Director or Magisterial District Judge and want to cross file, can I circulate both the Democratic and Republican petitions?
  - Magisterial District Judge Yes. Since this is a non-partisan position you can circulate both.
  - School Director No. You can circulate the petition for the party that you are registered
    in, someone from the opposite party must circulate your other petition.
- Can someone who is not registered sign my petition?
  - No you must be a registered voter to sign a petition. If they are not registered you cannot register them on the spot and ask them to sign. The registration must first be processed by this office and go through a 10 day waiting period before they are a registered voter.
- What if someone makes a mistake when signing my petition?
  - DO NOT use white out or scribble anything out on a petition. If a mistake is made simply draw 1 single line through the incorrect information and either write above or draw a line through the entire entry and move to the next line.
- Will the Election Office fill out my petition?
  - No, as a candidate that is your responsibility. Of course we are always there to help with any questions you have, however with every petition packet we provide you with a complete set of instructions on how to fill out all the paperwork necessary to run for office. Your petition should be filled out **PRIOR** to circulating not when you come into the office.
- Does the Election Office check all the information on the petitions and Financial Interest Statements to make sure it is correct?
  - No it is the responsibility of the candidate or the circulator to make sure all the requirements are followed. However, if you do not follow the election rules you run the risk of someone challenging your petition and having to go to court.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - CONTINUED

- How do you determine where my name appears on the ballot?
  - Casting of lots. We draw numbers to determine who goes on the ballot in the first position, second position, etc.
- What happens after the Primary Election?
  - O If you win your parties seat your name will appear on the Municipal Ballot in November. We do not send out anything indicating that you have won/lost. Unofficial results are available on our web site, <a href="www.schuylkillcountypa.gov">www.schuylkillcountypa.gov</a>, election night.
- If I lose in the Primary can I change my party and run as a third party candidate for the November Municipal Election?
  - No, you would have had to change your party BEFORE the close of registration in the Primary Election cycle. The only way to run in November without winning your party nomination is to run a write-in campaign.
- When can I get results, including write-ins, after the Primary Election?
  - Please be aware that it takes us about 10 days to accumulate the write-in votes, and nothing is official until we certify our results to the Department of State. Please be aware that we are not "putting you off", during a Municipal Primary there are usually thousands of write-ins that we have to count one by one so it is a long and drawn out process.
