- 1. Make sure you are topped off with fuel before turning onto RR965 there is no gas station in our area.
- 2. Backpacks.
- 3. Bikes/ ATV (there are unending miles of roadways).
- 4. ChapStick.
- 5. Hiking boots (it's rocky in many areas).
- 6. Long sleeve shirts.
- 7. Neck socks.
- 8. Pocket knife.
- 9. Sunglasses.
- 10. Swimsuits for the hot tub.
- 11. Walking sticks.
- 12. Water jugs (we have a water filter in the fridge).
- 13. Whistles.
- 14. Wide brim hats.

Winter/ Snow Season:



It snows up at The Outpost during January - March, and it can also ice over / hail during those months, so here's some additional reminders. Snow shovels and ice scrapers are available for you to use:

- 1. ChapStick.
- 2. Diesel vehicles: glow plugs/ electric block heater.
- 3. Earmuffs.

- 5. Jackets.
- 6. Park under barn roof this will help stop icing and also protect from hail.
- 7. Scarves.
- 8. Snowboards, skis, snowshoes, etc. Its hilly, so it's fun for cross country. There are also quite a few downslopes in the area.

- 12. Wet weather boots.
