Dear Members of Quota International of Fort Lauderdale,

This isn't the typical thank you letter – it's a personal thank you from the bottom of my heart!

Even before the tragedy at MSD High School, I sought an estimate for a security system for the front door of our new center. The way the center is set up, causes the front door to be unsupervised frequently. Finances have been very tight because construction expenses to get into this building exceeded our estimates, but I took a step of faith and ordered a magnetic lock system, with a card reader, buzzer, camera and intercom system. I wasn't sure how we were going to pay for it, but I knew that it was necessary.

Imagine my delight when Dorothy called and asked if there was anything we needed. ADT was coming to install the system on the following day. It had cost us about \$1000.00 to fix the door and the security system was \$1650.00. Your donation of \$750.00 was a tremendous help!

#### THE ORIGINAL "FIVE" Quota Club International

"The idea for Quota International was sparked when Wanda Frey Joiner attended a Christmas "ladies' night" party hosted by the Kiwanis Club of Buffalo, New York. Wanting to form a similar organization for women to join, a few weeks later, Joiner and four businesswomen, Florence M. Smith, Alice C. Sauers, Ora G. Cole, and Jean Ware Redpath, signed incorporation documents forming Quota Club International on February 6, 1919, one year before the United States passed the 19th Amendment granting women the right to vote and less than one month after the end of World War I. Because many women had joined the workforce and organized campaigns to support the troops, when the war was over, women wanted more employment and empowerment opportunities. Their enthusiasm propelled the organization to become the first international women-only service organization in 1925.

The five founders chose to keep their dream simple by using the "golden rule" as their code and the "sharing" of both talent and responsibility as its ideal. During the early years of Quota, the organization's focus targeted and promoted: good citizenship, crime prevention, extending friendly relations, gaining recognition for the achievements of women, and international relations."
