

Fort Lauderdale Wins "FEEL THE LOVE AWARD"

Jo Anderson and President Sheila presented our Grad Night project using the items collected in the box Carole Hart decorated. There was also a short slide presentation with pictures.



It so happened that this was the same project for which we submitted an essay for an award. As President Sheila mentioned in her Report of Conference, we won the "Feel the Love" Award which is given each year "to the club with the most effective and far-reaching project for disadvantaged women and children." Our sponsorship of the 16 young girls to participate in "Grad Night" at Universal Studios was the winning submission! Pictures of the girls at Universal and the essay that Service Chair Dorothy Seibert wrote sealed the deal. Dorothy's essay (limited to 150 words) follows:

Feel the Love Award Application Quota International of Fort Lauderdale, Inc.

"The Grad Night Bash is a tradition for graduating seniors at Universal Studios, including rides, adventures, music and a live concert.

Pace Center for Girls operates 19 Centers throughout Florida and one in Georgia. Their documented highly successful prevention program offers year-round counseling and academic services for girls at-risk for juvenile delinquency, failing, dropping out of school, running away or experiencing home difficulties.

Some of the Broward PACE girls miss attending typical high school experiences like football/basketball, prom and Grad Night, thus they choose to return to their home schools, foregoing needed academic, psychological and social support at PACE.

QI Fort Lauderdale wanted to give graduating seniors of Broward Pace the opportunity to attend Grad Bash. The girls prepared a detailed proposal.

Their Advisor reports excited anticipation for the trip. For some of the girls the expectation has been a needed incentive for graduation from PACE."
