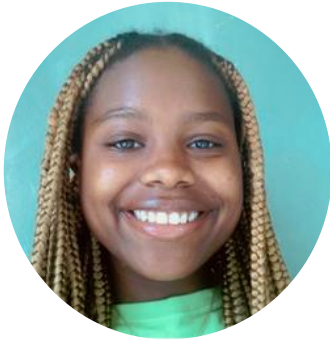
Lunch Meeting at Sea Watch

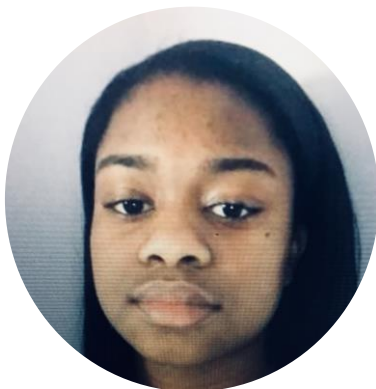
\$11,000 Scholarships Presented
