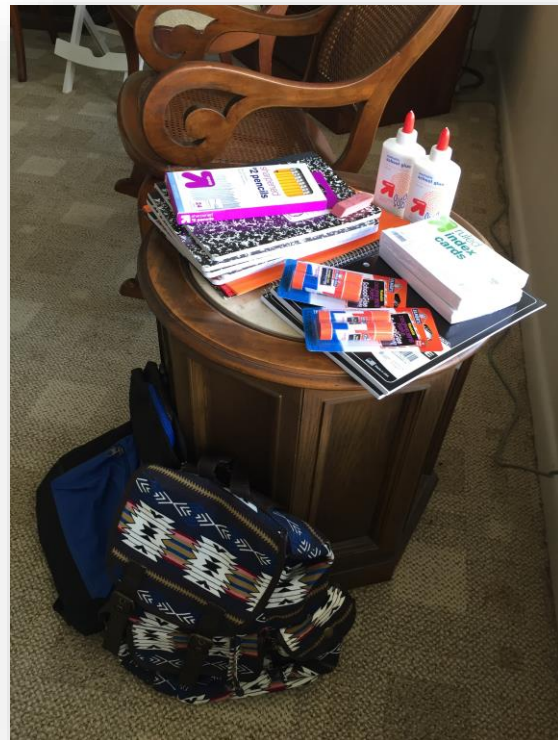
ETHAN RECEIVES HIS NEW BACKPACK
