Dear Members of Quota Club of Fort Lauderdale:

I hope and pray that you are all healthy and well. Thank you so much for remembering us at God's Little Lambs. A couple of our community partners have disbanded during this pandemic, so we really appreciate your donation.

We currently have 78 children enrolled. The cost of supplies and extra payroll to keep the children separated has stretched our budget. We have had to quarantine classrooms several times. Whenever a child is exposed to covid, the parents have to keep them home for at least 10 days. These families cannot afford to pay when they are out of work, so we take that loss of income. Yet, I haven't asked for funds because the last two years have been difficult and tumultuous for everyone. And then, I receive a surprise donation blessing that wasn't expected! God bless you all!

Over 90 of enrolled children pay a reduced tuition which is made possible through donations from individuals and organizations who love children. So far this year, God's Little Lambs has provided \$55,000 in tuition scholarships. On behalf of the staff and children at God's Little Lambs, I would like to thank you for partnering with us to help break the cycle of poverty with your generous donation.
