The National Retail Federation expects Americans to spend a whopping \$7.5 billion on food items this year, which means the trucking industry has been very busy getting freight into position ahead of weekend- long fourth of July Celebrations. The July 4th freight task is estimated at around 72,000 truckloads. That included a billion pounds of meat, 68 million cases of beer and 2,500 truckloads of fireworks shipped in June alone.
