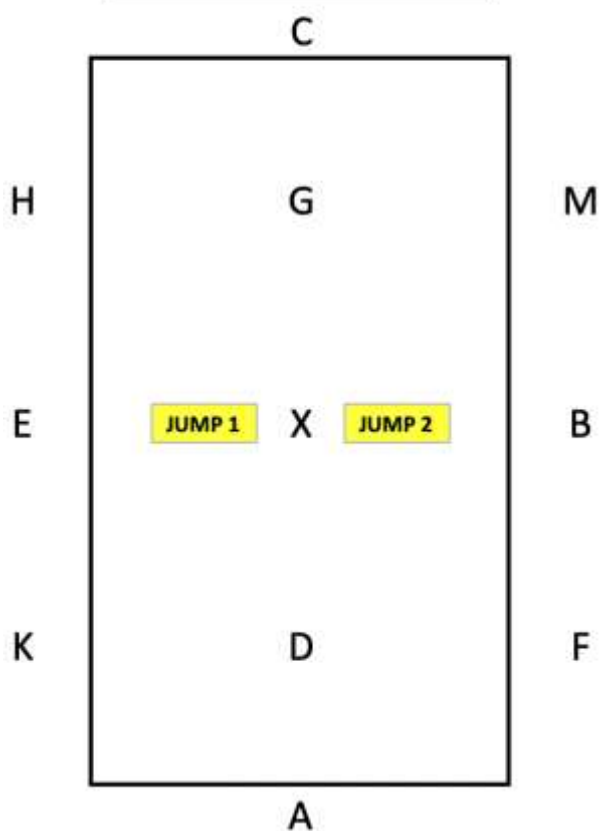

Jump for Joy Freeform Dressage Tests are for horses and ponies with jumping experience and can be ridden with or without music.

To be ridden in snaffle bridle.

Maximum height of fences are 60cm cross poles. There is no minimum height. You do not need to jump the fences in order.

All trot work will be performed rising.

A few canter strides are allowable after jump – excessive canter will be penalised.

Refusals and knock-downs will be penalised as an error of course with appropriate deduction of marks (see penalty mark box).

Knock-down penalty marks will be applied at the judge's discretion.
