Water Street Brewery Grafton was designed and constructed in collaboration with the owner, Flux Design, and Uihlein Wilson (now Ramlow Stein). The concept of the building was to mimic the landscape of Grafton and look like a milk farm converted to a pub-style restaurant. The structure of the building is timber-framed and was sourced from Montana. The timber structure was prefabricated and shipped to the project location. The prefabrication process allowed the structure to be installed onsite in a week.

The restaurant includes a brewery as you walk into the space as well as the one-of-a-kind memorabilia featured throughout the interior. The exterior of the building includes a grain silo placed on top of the building as well as an expansive deck that overhangs the wetland area along the south side of the building.
