

Scholarship Criteria for The Tom Sellu Scholarship Fund

Purpose:

The Tom Sellu Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to college-bound high school students based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an express interest in pursuing a university education in Education, Economics and Legal studies.

Criteria:

The students eligible for assistance must be high school students of Harford School for Girls and Moyamba Boys Secondary Schools in Moyamba, Sierra Leone and intend to continue their education at a four-year college or university. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need, behaviour record, and the student's community service record. Students should submit a scholarship application on the form provided by the Jamil & Nyanga Jaward Foundation website.

Guidelines:

Scholarships will be awarded to students on an annual basis and disbursed in equal payments in September, January and April directly to the Schools. Students must continue to attend classes and maintain no lower than an 85% grade-point average (or equivalent).

Amount:

Each scholarship awarded will be equal to the tuition fees, text and exercise books and mandatory schools supplies required. All school bills and lists must be provided at least one month before the close of school term.

Deadline:

The application deadline is July 1st. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted.

Renewal process:

This scholarship will be renewed for students promoted to a higher grade that meet the criteria above. Only high school students with excellent attendance and behaviour records will be eligible to re-apply.
