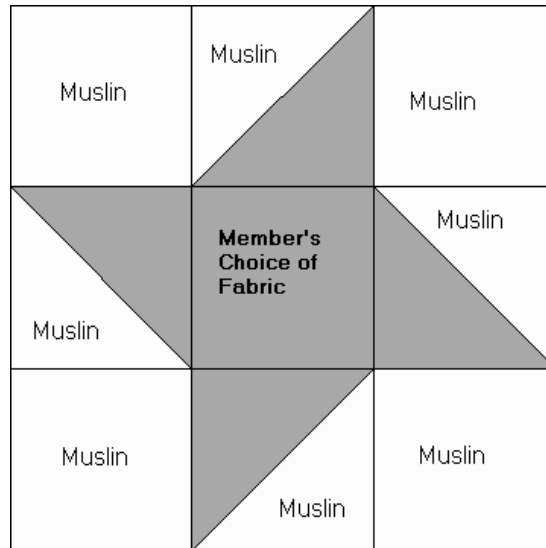


## Friendship Star Directions



### Fabric Needs:

Muslin – four 2.5" squares, two 3" squares

Member's Choice (MC) Fabric – one 2.5" square, two 3" squares

### Sewing Instructions:

1. On the back of the 3" squares of muslin fabric, mark a diagonal line. Match these squares up with the same size of the MC fabric right sides together. Use a scant 1/4" away from both sides of the diagonal line. To create 2 Half Triangle Squares (HTS) from each original square, cut on the diagonal line. Press open carefully, pressing seam toward MC fabric. Square up the 4 new units to 2.5".
2. Join a 2.5" square of muslin fabric to either side of an HTS unit just created...per the diagram above. Press seams toward corner squares. Make 2 of these units

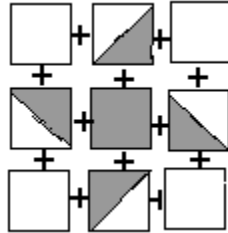

3. Join other 2 HTS units on either side of the 2.5" MC fabric per the diagram below. Press seams toward the center square.



4. Join units together to create Friendship Star block.



5. **IMPORTANT:** Please square up your finished block to be sure it is 6.5". If it is larger or smaller, check your seams and redo if necessary. If you do not check your measurements, your block may not join properly with other blocks easily to create a finished quilt.

### Notes:

The block will be 6.5 x 6.5 inches cut, 6 x 6 inches finished

Please sign and date your block with a fabric permanent pen

Take account seam allowances when signing your block so your signature does not get lost when blocks are sewn together
