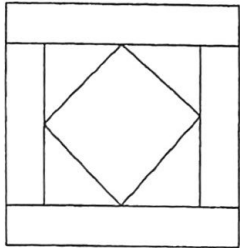


Comfort Quilt Directions

Top is set 7" x 9" blocks alternating Square in Square with Snowball blocks.

Square in a Square with Border - make 32

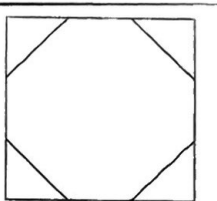
Draw diagonal line across 3" squares. Right sides together and outer corner edges even, layer a 3" square on top of a 5" square. Sew on marked line, then trim off corner 1/4" from seam line. Press and square to 5". Add 2 1/2" by 5" logs to sides then add 2 1/2" by 9 1/2" logs to top and bottom. Trim square to 8". Extra width on logs is given in case middle square is under 5" trimmed.



For inner square and border logs, use the same fabric with contrasting 3" squares. I try to use as many fabrics as possible and try not to repeat a combination more than twice.

Snowball Blocks - make 31

Draw a diagonal line across 3" squares. Right sides together and outer corner edges even, layer a dark 3" square on top of an 8" cream square. Sew on marked line, then trim off corner 1/4" from seam line, and press the dark triangle up. Repeat for all 4 corners. Square should be 8".



I try to use the same color for all of the 3" squares sometimes using the same fabric as the outer border.

Comfort Quilt Directions

Set in 9 rows of 7 squares. Row 1 begins with Square in Square, Row 2 begins with Snowball etc. Add 2" inner border. Outer border is 4 1/2". Approximate size is 63.5" x 78.5".

Fabric needed

11" x 11" for middle square & logs, 6" x 6" for 3" squares for each block.

Approx 3 1/2 yards of assorted contrasting fabrics

1 1/3 yards neutral tone on tone for snowball block

1/3 yard for corner triangles on snowball block

1/3 yard for inner border

1 yard for border

1/2 yard for binding

4 yards for backing

Batting - 83" x 68"
