Discussion Questions

- 1. When you hear the word Halloween, what emotions or associations come up for you and why?
- 2. How does understanding All Hallows' Tide (All Hallows' Eve, All Saints, All Souls) change the way you view this time of year?
- 3. What does Acts 10 ("Do not call unclean what I have made clean") teach us about how we label things or people as "evil" or "off-limits"?
- 4. Why do you think fear and superstition so easily replace joy and remembrance in Christian practice?
- 5. What did you learn about how the early Church transformed pagan customs rather than avoiding them entirely?
- 6. How might the Church reclaim the symbols of this season (like candles, skulls, and feasts) as expressions of Christ's victory over death?
- 7. Which part of Church history surprised you the most, and how does it impact your faith today?

Reflection / Application

- How can your family or community redeem Oct 31–Nov 2 as days of worship and remembrance rather than fear or compromise?
- What would it look like to "reclaim the feast" in your own home this year?

- 2. What was most surprising about the history of the Satanic Panic and how it influenced the Church's thinking?

- 4. How does understanding the truth about Wicca, LaVey, and pop culture change the way we approach conversations about witchcraft or the occult today?
- 5. What Christian roots did you discover behind trick-or-treating and costumes that you didn't know before?
- 6. What's the danger of letting fear-based narratives shape Christian practice instead of Scripture and Church history?
- 7. How can modern believers practically reclaim All Hallows' Tide through prayer, generosity, and remembrance?

Reflection / Application

- How can you personally be a light of truth and peace during a season that many Christians fear?
- What might it look like for your church or ministry to model this kind of redemptive understanding next year?
