

This list is not exhaustive. However it is a starting point and guide to help you to be ready to enjoy your new family member.

Food and water bowls.

Crate. A crate is an essential investment in many ways. It provides a safe place for puppy during transportation. It helps with potty training and provides a den/bed where your pup can retreat for rest. When choosing a crate keep in mind that your puppy is going to grow! By six months your puppy may be over 70 pounds and by a year he/she may exceed 100 pounds. If you have a crate your pup will have a place where they can be safe and you won't have to worry that your shoes/couch/etc. will be a puppy chew toy.

Puppy pads.

Leash, harness and collar. Select high quality adjustable items and remember your pup is going to GROW! You will probably go through several sizes.

Puppy food. We recommend high quality large breed puppy chow such as Royal Canin to provide the nutrition your pup needs for rapid growth.

Puppy gates (or baby gates). Keeping your pup in a restricted area will make your life easier.

Puppy-friendly toys.

Puppy safe treats.

Bedding/dog bed.

Dog tooth paste and tooth brush.

Quality dog nail trimmer.

Pet stain remover, just in case!
