

ANNUAL MEMBERS JURIED SHOW Oct. 20th 2026

3D EXHIBITS RULES AND CRITERIA

Absolute Deadline to submit is Oct. 16th 2026

1. The 3D Exhibit can be ceramics, basketry, wire, assemblage or any 3D created sculpture which can stand alone on the Art Room countertop or floor with the bottom flattened or on a base.
2. The weight limit should not exceed more than 15 pounds for countertop (Special considerations can be made, including size, with Exhibits Chair)
3. **Art must be brought to the Art Room for jurying on Monday afternoon, Oct. 19th, between 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm.**
4. Art will be displayed in the Conference Room during the Reception and in the Art Room during the period of the Annual Members Juried Exhibit, Oct. 20th 2026 thru Jan. 12th 2027 unless you inform Exhibits Chair you will remove them.

RULES:

1. A maximum of **two** 3D art works per artist, can be entered in the Annual Members Juried Show. If you enter a 2D piece. Then only 1 3D will be accepted. BOTH will be judged.
2. Total fee to enter the show: **\$15**. Make out check to VACA and attach to contract or include cash.
3. The artwork must be the member's own original work.
4. AMJS Committee will place the artwork as it deems appropriate at the reception.
5. The decisions of the AMJS Committee are final.

CRITERIA which must be met or the artwork will be rejected:

1. The artist or their designee must deliver the artwork to the specified room at the specified date and time, Monday Oct. 19th between 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm to the Art Room.
2. Artwork must be ready to be displayed on a steady base or with a flattened bottom so that it stands alone on a table, counter, or floor.
4. Information must be taped on the back or bottom of your artwork, with your name, title of work, phone number.
5. A signed statement that this is the artist's own original work.
6. A signed Liability Waiver.

SALE OF ARTWORKS FROM THE EXHIBIT

1. Anyone with any interest in purchasing artwork should contact the artist directly.
3. Purchaser will make payment directly to the artist.
4. The artist will immediately send the **required 10% commission** check payable to Arts and Crafts Association to Treasurer Suzanne Ferris 8419 Chenin Blanc Lane, SJ, CA 95135 or leave the check in the Arts & Crafts Assoc, mailbox in Cribari Center. The sold artwork may be replaced, or not, for the remainder of the show, at the AMJS Chair's discretion.

ARTWORKS LEFT AT EXHIBIT

1. Artworks are to be picked up between 12:30 and 1:30 on Jan. 12th 2027, from the room in which they were exhibited, as agreed to in the Exhibit Contract/Liability Waiver. If requesting your artwork to be removed before that date please contact Show Chair Michael Sunzeri.
2. If an artist asks someone else to pick up the artwork, it must be picked up and signed for by that person, at the designated time and place.
3. The Exhibit Committee will not release any artwork without a written note with permission from the artist or contact made to the AMJS Chair.
4. The Exhibit Committee will not be responsible for any artwork not picked up at the appropriate time. That includes any damage done during moving or storage or hanging, and theft, loss or vandalism. Art works not picked up will be stored in the Art Room. Every effort will be made to secure the safety and integrity of all art.

MEMBERSHIP IN ARTS AND CRAFTS ASSOCIATION

Artists must be club members to exhibit their work. To become a member, send a check for **\$15**, payable to Arts & Crafts Association, or VACA. Send your application to Membership Chair Claudia Welch, 2064 Folle Branche Dr. SJ, CA 95135 or place in the Arts & Crafts Assoc. mailbox in Cribari Center. **\$15 to enter AMJS is also required.**

Keep these two above pages for your records and return the below Application noting it is for AMJS to the Cribari mailbox or Michael Sunzeri along with your entry fee of \$15.

CONTRACT and RELEASE OF LIABILITY for 3D Art

The contract can be downloaded from villagesartsandcrafts.com or find a hard contract in the Art Room, Ceramics Lab, or Cribari mailbox, complete and sign it, then return to the Arts & Crafts Assoc. mailbox in Cribari Center noting AMJS or to Michael's home address, 6130 Montgomery Ct.

Sign and return to the Arts & Crafts Assoc. mailbox **by Oct. 16th 2026** to enter the Annual Members Juried Art Show. Put the signed contract and **\$15** in an envelope with Michael's name on it. **Bring your art to the Art Room on Monday Oct. 19th, between 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm to be juried for the show.**

Ceramics or 3D works will be exhibited in the Art Room from Oct. 20th 2026 thru Jan. 12th 2027, unless you inform Exhibit Chair that you are removing them.

The maximum number of 3D pieces to be judged is **2** per artist unless submitting a 2D piece as well. Then only **1** 3D is accepted. Any Sculpture, Ceramics or 3D pieces accepted.
