□ Arugula	 A cool season crop. Peppery, tart and slightly bitter flavour (becomes more bitter with warmer weather) Ideally used in salads, sandwiches, sauces Rince with cool water to clean Refrigerate for storage
□ Basil	 Grown in warmer weather. Many culinary uses. Used medicinally. Can be dried and stored For fresh basil place stems in water or refrigerate leaves Oils can be extracted.
□ Beans	 Grown in warmer weather Grassy, sweet, and sometimes nutty flavour Use steamed, fresh, fried, baked. Freezes well (blanch first) For fresh beans refrigerate
□ Beets	 Grown in warmer weather Very earthy flavour and slightly sweet. Eaten fresh, pickled, and some recipes require cooking. Can be refrigerated
