

Summary of Legislative Action on Education Bills

- **HB 544. “Propagation of divisive concepts.” (Censorship)**
 - Laid on table by legislature, but passed in state budget(HB2)
 - *****Federal Lawsuit challenging this bill has been filed by the ACLU-NH, consolidating a lawsuit of the AFT and NEA. Plaintiffs in the lawsuit are Andres Majia, Diversity Director in SAU 16, and Tina Philibotte from the Manchester school district.**
- **HB1576 and HB1090. Attempts to repeal HB2 (HB544); laid on table. (Means voted down.)**
- **HB1632. Would limit when you could teach civil rights; laid on table. (Means voted down.)**
- **HB1255. Requiring teacher loyalty. ITL (Inexpedient to legislate.)**
